

#### DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

IN THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS, A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE INCLUDES ANY SHOW AWARD THAT COUNTS TOWARDS THE TITLE OF CHAMPION UNDER THE RULES OF ANY GOVERNING BODY RECOGNISED BY THE KENNEL CLUB. WINS AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW IN BREED CLASSES WHERE CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES ARE NOT ON OFFER SHALL BE COUNTED AS WINS AT OPEN SHOWS.

IN ESTIMATING THE NUMBER OF AWARDS WON, ALL WINS UP TO AND INCLUDING THE 7th DAY (3rd AUGUST 2019) BEFORE THE DATE OF CLOSING OF ENTRIES SHALL BE COUNTED WHEN ENTERING FOR ANY CLASS.

WINS IN VARIETY CLASSES DO NOT COUNT FOR ENTRY IN BREED CLASSES, BUT WHEN ENTERING FOR VARIETY CLASSES, WINS IN BOTH BREED AND VARIETY CLASSES MUST BE COUNTED. A FIRST PRIZE DOES NOT INCLUDE A SPECIAL PRIZE OF WHATEVER VALUE.

A DOG IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY IN VARIETY CLASSES UNLESS ALSO ENTERED & SUBSEQUENTLY EXHIBITED IN A BREED CLASS WHERE SUCH A CLASS IS PROVIDED FOR WHICH IT IS ELIGIBLE. EXEMPTIONS FROM THIS REGULATION ARE:-

- FROM 1ST JANUARY 2017, AND FOR A PERIOD OF 1 YEAR THE KENNEL CLUB SHOW REGULATIONS WHICH STIPULATE THAT DOGS MUST BE ENTERED & EXHIBITED IN A BREED CLASS BEFORE EXHIBITING IN AN AV CLASS/STAKES CLASS & THAT ONLY UNBEATEN DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE GROUP OR BIS COMPETITIONS ARE SUSPENDED
- (1) A PUPPY, UNLESS A CLASS FOR DOGS UNDER 12 MONTHS OF AGE FOR WHICH IT IS ELIGIBLE IS PROVIDED FOR THE BREED.
  - (2) A DOG IN ANY VARIETY VETERAN CLASS
  - (3) AS PROVIDED IN KENNEL CLUB DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES.

IF AN EXHIBITOR REPORTS BEFORE THE JUDGING OF A CLASS OR CLASSES THAT A DOG HAS BEEN ENTERED WHICH IS INELIGIBLE, THE EXHIBITOR MAY CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:-

- (1) WITHDRAWAL - THE DOG MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM COMPETITION SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS OF REGULATIONS 9(j) AND 20.
  - (2) TRANSFER -  
(A) IF A DOG IS INELIGIBLE FOR A CLASS OR CLASSES AS REGARDS ITS BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER IT TO THE EQUIVALENT CLASS OR CLASSES FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT AND, IN THE EVENT OF THERE BEING NO EQUIVALENT CLASS, MINOR PUPPY & PUPPY EXCEPTED, TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.  
(B) FOR AN EXHIBIT ENTERED INCORRECTLY IN A MINOR PUPPY CLASS OR PUPPY CLASS, WHICH IS OVER AGE BUT UNDER 12 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE OR 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE RESPECTIVELY, THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER THE EXHIBIT TO THE PUPPY CLASS OR THE JUNIOR CLASS RESPECTIVELY FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT AND IN THE EVENT OF THERE BEING NO PUPPY OR JUNIOR CLASS RESPECTIVELY TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.  
(C) FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN THE ABOVE, THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER IT TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
- IF AN EXHIBIT ARRIVES LATE AND MISSES A CLASS, EVEN IF IT IS THE ONLY CLASS IN WHICH IT IS ENTERED, THE DOG MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANY OTHER CLASS.

<b>MINOR PUPPY</b>	FOR DOGS OF 6 & NOT EXCEEDING 9 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW.
<b>PUPPY</b>	FOR DOGS OF 6 & NOT EXCEEDING 12 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW
<b>JUNIOR</b>	FOR DOGS OF 6 & NOT EXCEEDING 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW
<b>MAIDEN</b>	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE/CACIB/CAC/GREEN STAR OR A FIRST PRIZE AT AN OPEN OR CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT.)
<b>NOVICE</b>	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE/CACIB/CAC/GREEN STAR OR THREE OR MORE FIRST PRIZES AT OPEN OR CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT.)
<b>YEARLING</b>	FOR DOGS OF 12 & NOT EXCEEDING 24 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW.
<b>GRADUATE</b>	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE/CACIB/CAC/GREEN STAR OR FOUR OR MORE FIRST PRIZES AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT WHERE CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES ARE ON OFFER IN THE BREED
<b>POST GRADUATE</b>	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE/CACIB/CAC/GREEN STAR OR FIVE OR MORE FIRST PRIZES AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT WHERE CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES ARE ON OFFER IN THE BREED
<b>OPEN</b>	FOR ALL DOGS OF ALL BREEDS FOR WHICH THE CLASS IS PROVIDED AND ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW.
<b>BRACE</b>	FOR TWO EXHIBITS (EITHER SEX OR MIXED) OF ONE BREED BELONGING TO THE SAME EXHIBITOR, EACH EXHIBIT HAVING BEEN ENTERED IN SOME CLASS OTHER THAN BRACE
<b>VETERAN</b>	FOR DOGS OF SEVEN YEARS OF AGE AND OVER ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW.
<b>NON-SPORTING</b>	CONFINED TO THE EXHIBITION OF BREEDS OF DOGS WITHIN THE TOY, WORKING, PASTORAL AND UTILITY GROUPS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW
<b>SPORTING</b>	CONFINED TO THE EXHIBITION OF BREEDS OF DOGS WITHIN THE GUNDOG, HOUND, AND TERRIER GROUPS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW.
<b>NOT FOR COMPETITION</b>	SOCIETIES AT THEIR DISCRETION MAY ACCEPT NOT FOR COMPETITION ENTRIES SOCIETIES MAY ACCEPT SUCH ENTRIES FROM BREEDS OF DOGS NOT INCLUDED WITHIN THE TITLE OF THE SOCIETY & AT SHOWS HELD OVER MORE THAN ONE DAY, SUCH ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED ON ANY DAY AT ANY BREED.

16. ALL DOGS RESIDENT OUTSIDE THE UK MUST BE ISSUED WITH A KENNEL CLUB AUTHORITY TO COMPETE NUMBER BEFORE ENTRY TO THE SHOW/EVENT CAN BE MADE. ALL OVERSEAS ENTRIES WITHOUT AN AUTHORITY TO COMPETE NUMBER WILL BE RETURNED TO THE EXHIBITOR/COMPETITOR.
17. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS - ANYONE WHOSE DOGS IS ENTERED AT A KENNEL CLUB LICENSED EVENT SHOULD NOT PUT A DOG'S HEALTH AND WELFARE AT RISK BY ANY ACTION, DEFAULT, OMISSION OR OTHERWISE. BREACH OF KENNEL CLUB REGULATIONS IN THIS RESPECT MAY BE REFERRED TO THE BOARD FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER KENNEL CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

KEEP THE DOG IN THE SHADE - TAKE YOUR OWN SHADE FOR EXAMPLE A LARGE UMBRELLA AND ALWAYS HAVE PLENTY OF WATER AVAILABLE TO DRINK SO YOUR DOG STAYS WELL HYDRATED.  
AVOID YOUR DOG TAKING PART IN UNNECESSARY EXERTION, OR FROM STANDING IN EXPOSED SUNLIGHT FOR EXTENDED LENGTHS OF TIME.  
REMEMBER, IF YOU FEEL HOT YOUR DOG IS VERY LIKELY TO FEEL MUCH HOTTER AND DEHYDRATED, AND THIS COULD LEAD TO DIRE RESULTS. PLEASE LOOK AFTER YOUR DOG'S WELFARE.

1. THE SHOW WILL OPEN AT 9.30am.
2. DOGS WILL BE RECEIVED AT ANY TIME BUT IT IS THE EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT EXHIBITS ARE AVAILABLE FOR JUDGING WHEN REQUIRED.
3. JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 10.00am PROMPT IN SCHEDULE ORDER
4. EXHIBITS MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW AFTER THEIR JUDGING HAS BEEN COMPLETED. THE SHOW WILL CLOSE HALF AN HOUR AFTER ALL JUDGING HAS BEEN COMPLETED.
5. THE USE OF COOKING STOVES IN THE PROXIMITY OF TENTING AND BENCHING AREAS IS FORBIDDEN EXCEPT AS AUTHORISED BY THE SHOW MANAGEMENT.
6. ENTRY FEES:- FIRST ENTRY PER DOG £6.00  
SUBSEQUENT ENTRIES WITH SAME DOG £1.00 PER CLASS  
STAKE CLASSES:- £1.00 PER ENTRY = AS 1st ENTRY £6  
CATALOGUES:- £3.00 WITH ENTRY; £3.50 ON THE DAY  
EXHIBITORS MAY APPLY FOR ADDITIONAL WRISTBANDS (PERMITS ACCESS TO DOG SHOW AND WESTMORLAND AGRICULTURAL SHOW) FOR FAMILY AND FRIENDS AT £12 INSTEAD OF THE NORMAL ADMISSION RATES, SUBJECT TO THE WRISTBANDS BEING PURCHASED ON OR BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES.  
MAXIMUM OF 4 EXTRA WRISTBANDS PER EXHIBITOR.

9. PUPPIES UNDER 6 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION.
10. THE MATING OF BITCHES WITHIN THE PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW IS FORBIDDEN.
11. BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.  
WHERE A BEST PUPPY IN SHOW COMPETITION IS SCHEDULED THE BEST PUPPY IN SHOW IS A PUPPY WHICH HAS COMPETED AND HAS BEEN DECLARED BEST PUPPY IN BREED, BEST ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED PUPPY OR BEST ANY VARIETY IMPORTED BREED REGISTER PUPPY. A PUPPY IS A DOG OF SIX AND NOT EXCEEDING TWELVE CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW. WHERE THE BEST OF BREED, BEST IN GROUP OR BEST IN SHOW IS A PUPPY IT SHOULD AUTOMATICALLY BE AWARDED BEST PUPPY IN BREED, BEST PUPPY IN GROUP AND BEST PUPPY IN SHOW RESPECTIVELY. WHERE THE RESERVE BEST OF BREED, RESERVE BEST OF GROUP OR RESERVE BEST IN SHOW IS A PUPPY WHICH HAS ONLY BEEN BEATEN BY AN ADULT DOG IT SHOULD ALSO AUTOMATICALLY BE BEST PUPPY IN BREED, BEST PUPPY IN GROUP AND BEST PUPPY IN SHOW RESPECTIVELY. CONSEQUENTLY, SELECTION OF BEST PUPPY IN BREED, BEST PUPPY IN GROUP AND BEST PUPPY IN SHOW MUST FOLLOW THE SELECTION OF BEST OF BREED, BEST IN GROUP AND BEST IN SHOW RESPECTIVELY.
12. BEST IN SHOW  
THE DOG DECLARED BEST IN SHOW IS A DOG WHICH HAS COMPETED AND HAS BEEN DECLARED BEST OF BREED, BEST ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED OR BEST ANY VARIETY IMPORTED BREED REGISTER. SHOWS JUDGED ON THE GROUP SYSTEM  
(DEFINITION; SHOWS JUDGED ON THE GROUP SYSTEM INCLUDES CLASSES FOR BREEDS WITHIN MORE THAN ONE GROUP, AS DEFINED IN KENNEL CLUB REGULATION B(A); AND REQUIRE A JUDGE TO DECLARE A BEST OF EACH GROUP AFTER WHICH THE EXHIBITS SO DECLARED WILL COMPETE FOR THE AWARD OF BEST IN SHOW AND RESERVE BEST IN SHOW.)  
1) BEST OF BREED  
WHERE A BREED IS SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED A BEST OF BREED MAY BE DECLARED BUT ONLY FROM THOSE DOGS WHICH HAVE RECEIVED A FIRST PRIZE IN A BREED CLASS AT THE SHOW. WHERE SEPARATE CLASSES ARE PROVIDED FOR EACH SEX OF A BREED A BEST OF EACH SEX MUST BE DECLARED.  
2) BEST OF GROUP  
BEST OF GROUP AND SUBSEQUENT PLACINGS MUST BE SELECTED FROM:-  
A) THE BEST OF BREED WINNERS IN EACH GROUP  
B) THE BEST DOG FROM THE ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED CLASSES IN EACH GROUP OR ON EACH DAY.  
C) THE BEST DOG FROM ANY VARIETY IMPORTED BREED REGISTER CLASSES IN EACH GROUP OR ON EACH DAY.

KENNEL CLUB SHOW REGULATION - F  
REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- 1) These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition at a show. When a dog is found to have been prepared for exhibition in contravention of these regulations the exhibitor will be dealt with as if a complaint under Kennel Club Rule 42 had been lodged against them and proved to the satisfaction of the General Committee without prejudice to the right of the exhibitor to make representations to the General Committee in mitigation of the penalty to be imposed at the discretion of the General Committee under Rule 42. The dog will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and any award gained thereat.
- 2) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition either before or at the show. Any other substance which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat of a dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3) No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed and nothing may be done, calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive, except:-
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee
  - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any kind.
  - (c) The shortening of tails of customary docked breeds.
  - (d) Operations to prevent breeding where the animal has progeny registered at the Kennel Club.
- 4) The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5) Any individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6) Any objection by an individual related to a infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
